

Total area after NON Technical Surveys 64.611.122 m²




Work Plan


- Stage 1: "Organization" (executed). Creation of DICOR (National Military Authority).
- Stage 2: "Financing" (in execution) Requested US\$2,000,000.
- Stage 3: "Preparation" (First semester 2023) reorganization and training of EOD Units. Technical Units specialists <u>without gender discrimination</u>.
- Stage 4: "Operations" (July 2023 to June 2026). Clear and destroy cluster munitions remnants.




"Pampa Chaca Este" Reduced Areas and CHA



"Barrancas" Reduced Areas and CHA




"Delta" Reduced Areas and CHA




"Punta Zenteno" Reduced Areas and CHA
